Dalton Town Council	The grant would be used to support funding in place from Dalton Town Council and Billincote Charity for Multisports Activities which the Dalton Neighbourhood Community Team organise in conjunction with DASH@Dowdales (Dalton Active Sports Hall) during the summer holidays.	The multisports events are an excellent opportunity to link in with our communities. The events encourage Dalton youths to engage with each other and the local community police team having a positive impact on community safety at a local level.	£1,800.00
Whitehaven Judo Club	The grant would be used to purchase two safety mattresses for the Judo players to learn new or advanced techniques. Also the grant would go towards the cost of printing flyers and posters.	The club welcomes children of any ability or background. The club also offers a schools outreach programme where Judo is delivered to local Copeland schools as a curriculum option not offered by other schools.	£2,500.00
Scotby Cricket Club	Scotby Cricket Club plans to provide additional opportunity for residents of Carlisle to take part in regular sport and physical activity in a number of different ways are outlined in the application form.	All members regardless of ability are given an equal opportunity to participate and the club promotes fairness and equality towards its membership. This is reflected in the Clubs Equity Policy. The current membership profile sees a mix of players aged from 12 upwards playing in the two club sides.	£2,500.00
Kells ARLFC	The grant will be used to upgrade the mini mod and youth team training equipment including the latest pitch protection equipment.	This will ensure that all mini mod and youth sections up to under 16 level would be able to participate in the learning, training and playing of amateur rugby league in the community in a safe and friendly environment.	£2,500.00
Signal Film and Media	The grant will support towards the cost of delivering a 20-week, evening filmmaking project. So far we have raised £5,000 from the Cumbria Housing Partners Fund (via Cumbria Community Foundation) and £2,000 from the Walney Extension Fund.	Our project will support the Police and Crime Plan by reducing anti-social behaviour, preventing re-offending and reducing hate crime. This will be achieved through provision of 20 workshops that bring together 11-16 year olds for positive film, media and digital activities that involve socializing, learning & gaining qualifications, in a non-academic setting especially designed to suit their needs.	£2,500.00

Aspatia Hornets	Our club has an ever expanding junior section and would like to train 5 more junior coaches. We are asking for funding to help towards these costs as well as upgrading and providing new training equipment to keep up with the bigger demand on the club.	Our scheme compliments the Commissioner's Police & Crime Plan in that this will help engage young people at an early age thus helping to reduce the impact of anti-social behaviour on our communities and also this (rugby) will encourage a healthy lifestyle which links in with the target of reducing the impact of alcohol abuse. All in all our scheme will help meet the target of addressing offender behaviour to reduce [adult and] youth offending and reoffending by engaging young people at an early age and helping them to channel their energies into a fulfilling and worthwhile activity.	£1,000.00
Blennerhasset School	Funding would be used to replace sport equipment such as large goal posts, outdoor toys and equipment which encourage teamwork and collaboration that were lost in the floods due to Storm Desmond. Funding would also be used to purchase IT equipment such as tablets and camera/film equipment which will be used in the new community classroom.	The funding will be used to develop the school as a hub for the community. We are currently developing a community project focusing on diminishing rural and social isolation called PALS (Pupils and Local Supporters) and have liaised with the PCSOs, Age Uk and Dementia Friends to plan community events which will promote communication between adults and children in the locality of Blennerhasset.	£1,500.00
