



## Police & Crime Commissioner Award Categories

The categories for the Commissioner's awards are:

- ❖ Community Super Hero Award
- ❖ Safer Super Hero Award (under 18's only)
- ❖ Outstanding Community Project Award
- ❖ Heart of the Community Award
- ❖ Above and Beyond Award

- ❖ The Commissioner's Annual Award

- **Community Safety Hero Award**

An individual who has made an impact in helping to keep people safe and/or to reduce crime. This contribution may impact the whole area, a local town, neighbourhood or even street, but it will have made a difference to the people located there. It could be someone who is working to bring communities together to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour, or who is working with people to deter and reduce offending.

- **Safer Super Hero Award (under 18's only)**

Someone who is aged 18 years or under who has made an impact in helping to keep people safe and/or to reduce crime. This contribution may impact the whole area, a local town, neighbourhood or even street, but it will have made a difference to the people located there. It could be someone who is working to bring communities together to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour, or is working with people to deter and reduce offending

- **Outstanding Community Project Award**

Where the outcome of an activity or project has had a positive impact on a community. For example:-

- ❖ Making a significant contribution to preventing, reducing or detecting crime in a certain area;
- ❖ Demonstrably building capacity or cohesion amongst a particular community;
- ❖ Making a significant contribution following an event or situation that would otherwise have had a negative impact on that community.

- **Heart of the Community Award**

The award's aim is to give people the chance to highlight those working tirelessly in their local communities on a voluntary basis; and who make a real difference to people's lives. Working with victims of crime; assisting to reduce crime, anti-social behaviour; or working with people to deter and reduce offending.

- **Above and Beyond Award**

An individual or team who have worked hard to reduce crime and disorder or improve services for victims of crime or disorder; often in challenging circumstances or going above and beyond their normal day-to-day roles to help make a difference. This could be in a local area, a specific service or a wider strategic or partnership impact.

- **The Commissioner's Annual Award**

The Commissioner will select the winner of this category from the winners of the above categories.
