North Cumbria Rescue and Response	Funding has been requested to provide a outboard engine to enable a faster response for water rescues.	This project will focus on providing a service which will work quicker to respond and rescue persons who have got into difficulties in water side settings. This will focus on supporting victims.	£2,500.00
Millom Recreation Centre	Funding has been requested to provide gymnastics equipment for a recreation centre which has a high intake of gymnasts enrolled.	This project will enable the young people in the area to become involved in a sport working as a diversionary activity which will help to reduce incidents of ASB.	£2,500.00

This project will encourage young people in the residential estate to congregate in an area away from properties. Maryport Amateur Operatic and Dramatic Society	Funding has been requested to provide costumes for every child involved in a production later in the year.	This project will encourage young people to take part in a production thus providing a diversionary activity which will help to reduce incidents of ASB.	£2,500.00

AWAZ Cumbria	Funding has been requested towards an "Escape to Safety" Exhibition and Bystander Training.	This project will help to prevent offending and reoffending and focus on Victims (including VAWG) through highlighting the problems victims have in travelling to safe places.	£1,180.00

This project will help to prevent offending and reoffending by offering young people an opportunity to become involved in a sport.
